The annual International Festival of Modern Art *Two Days and Two Nights of New Music* is one of the largest festivals for new music and performing art in Ukraine. The festival's action is unique because it was designed, according to the logic of its composer-founder's conception, as a grandiose 48-hour event, where various kinds of art are organically combined into a non-stop music spectacle, a large-scale composition-performance with a distinctive atmosphere shared by performers and Audience alike.

2019 is the celebration of the 25th anniversary of 2D2N - one of the largest and most informative festivals of New Music and New Performing Arts in Ukraine. In 2018, With the support of the Ukrainian Cultural Foundation, the double CD with the best works of previous festivals from 2008 to 2018 has been issued to the festival. An album is dedicated to the 25th anniversary of the festival. A new version of the festival site www.2d2n.art was created. An international conference and a series of concerts devoted to the 25th anniversary of the festival were held. The feature of the Festival-2019 is the wide usage of theatrical forms and genres. The program included about 130 works, and 30 of them were world premieres of Ukrainian and foreign composers. Many musical performances have a theatrical character, combined with artistic performance, sound, video, cinema and multimedia installations.

The history of the festival is to a certain extent also the history of New Music in Ukraine. The statistical calculation shows that in the 24 years, that is, 48 days of the festival as such plus several dozen days of preludes and postludes (over 500 hours of music in a whole), 2,212 performances of approximately 2,000 different works by 1,004 composers were carried out (the number of performed works is less than the number of performances due to repeated works, some of which even turned to a festival emblem). Please compare: the Slovak *Melos Ethos* festival in Bratislava for 27 years (1991–2017) has showed works by 486 composers, while the Polish *Warsaw Autumn* festival for 61 years (1956–2018 = 63 years, but two years were missed) has demonstrated works by 1669 composers.

These figures, reflecting the results of many-year festival activity, obviously can very eloquently speak for themselves.
